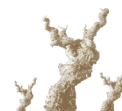

Fermentation took place in two flextank eggs using only whole berries without crushing to avoid over-extraction of tannins from skins or seeds. Hand plunged until dry then pressed to age in one 975 litre egg for 20 months on fine lees before racking and bottling.

This one needed some time to reveal its inner beauty, but we were patient and let it develop, resting on fine lees for 20 months to round off tannins and bring out the pedigree of the parcel.

The Provechón variety (also known as Bobal) has always formed part of the viticulture in Calatayud and was normally interplanted with Garnacha in post phylloxera plantings despite being prohibited by the DO until re-acceptance in 2016. El Matón is possibly the oldest remaining parcel in Aragon as a single vineyard of Provechón.
